

A Please turn it on after connecting all the option items.


Please disassemble I/O cover and stand **2** Please strongly tighten the plastic bolt at rear cover.

Please close I/O cover after inserting the cable into COM6/USB port of I/O ports.




SSD Replacement

Safety Precautions



Be careful not to spill any liquid on the screen.





I/O cover will be disassembled by pushing the "PUSH" part of both sides.





System Connection and Power on

Power Cord Connection

- A Please connect power addptor DC jack and power cord by turns after all option items are connected.

- Please insert power adaptor cable by turning it into DC 12V port at upper I/O ports.
- Please connect power cord after assembling it in a reverse way of disassemble.



Powen on

A Please turn the power on after installing all optional items.

Connect adapter and body rst before connecting power cord to a 220V (110V) outlet. Power supply is located on the lower right side of the monitor. When power is connected, the LED will light up. Each LED lamp will indicate the operation status.
